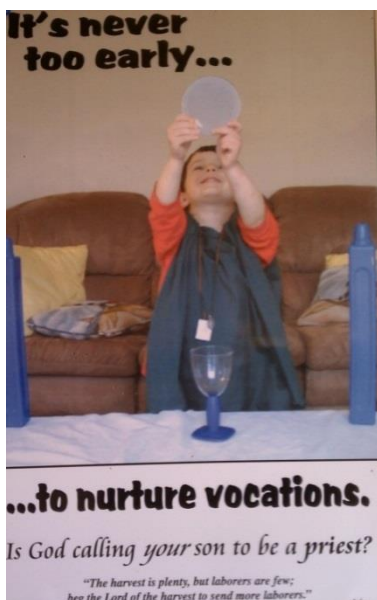
## STARTING ANEW:
